5. Academics

Candidate students have had modulations in all subjects in preparation for their final UCE, UACE, IDAAD and THANAWI examinations.

Senior four candidates completed their UCE exams while those for other candidates are still ongoing.

Senior one, two and three students have been given their end of year academic reports for both secular and theology, while senior five and thaani thanawi students shall pick theirs on first December 2023

Learners under the new competence based curriculum CBC have continued to do their projects in various subjects as below;

- Senior ones have done projects in Mathematics and Kiswahili language
- Senior two students have done projects in Geography, Agriculture, Fine Art and ICT
- Senior three students have done projects in English, physics and chemistry

Project based learning /assessment promotes creativity and innovativeness in the learners through identifying various problems in the society and then devise solution through project work

All learners under CBC are encouraged to bring laptops for personal use to enhance research

Senior three and four students are encouraged to buy the Chemistry, physics and biology practical books sold at school at a cost of 30,000/ each.

6. Discipline

The school disciplinary committee and the staff at large have continued to instill discipline in our students through the effective implementation of the school rules and regulations. On this note, some students with unbearable behaviors and characters were expelled, while others were suspended and others are strongly warned
